Jay Todd Sloane, known to many as Todd, was born on October 27, 1946 in Evansville, Indiana to James Benjamin and Louise Marie Sloane. Todd went to be with his Lord and Savior on November 26, 2014, at the age of 68, after a long battle due to complications from blood cancer and a stem cell transplant. Todd is preceded in death by his brother, Tom; his infant son; his mother, Louise; and his father, Ben. He graduated from Indiana State University in 1970 and was a member of the Sigma Tau Gamma Fraternity. Todd considered this church his family and was a devoted and faithful member, was head usher of the 8:30 am service and taught adult Sunday school classes. He never wanted to miss a service or his beloved Agape Sunday School class. Todd was in Sales most of his career and was employed by Pollock Investment Corp. Todd loved his work and especially his coworkers and clients.

His passion was for the Prison Missions, Kairos. Todd touched many lives through the sharing of his faith and love for the brothers-in-white at Hightower prison.
